Session Six: Acts Chapters 12, 13

Chapter 12 – Peter's Arrest and the Death of Herod

- Three Herod's
  - Herod Agrippa I Killed James
  - Herod Antipas Killed John the Baptist
  - Herod the Great Slaughter of the Innocents Visit of the Magi

VS 1-2 Herod kills James (brother of Jesus and head of the church in Jerusalem)

VS 3-4 Herod imprisons Peter – guarded with four squads (16 men)

Intended to be released after the Passover.

Date of Passover – 14<sup>th</sup> of Nissan – ordained by Moses in book of Exodus 12, Leviticus 23:5

Dated Changed – Council of Nicaea – first Sunday after the first full moon after the spring equinox.

Why? Quartodeciman's (fourteenism) – This group of Christians wanted to retain the Jewish date for Easter (Passover 14<sup>th</sup> of Nissan) however, the church councils rejected that view and determined to never have Christian "easter" on the same day as Jewish Passover. The Quartodeciman's were eventually "excommunicated."

VS 5 – 19 Peter's miraculous deliverance from prison.

- Prayer
- Angles
- Vision/Dream
- Rhoda
- Utter shock to see Peter at the door.
- Peter goes to another place (last we hear of Peter until Acts 15)

VS 20-24 Herod's Death

- Accepting the praises of men declaring him as God.
- Angel of the Lord strikes him dead.
- Eaten by worms.

VS 24-25 Church grows, Paul, Barnabas and Mark emerge.
