3 John 1:2 ESV

Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul.

Revelation 14:12 ESV

Here is a call for the endurance of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.

1 John 3:22 ESV

And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him. (what we ask for spiritually – a convertible is possible but not probable) (see below)

Galatians 5:22-23 ESV

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control... (pretty good list of responses to our requests/prayers)

John 14:27 ESV

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

1 Corinthians 6:19 ESV

Or do you not know that your body is a temple (dwelling place) of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own...

Proverbs 27:17 ESV

Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another.

Ephesians 4:11-12 ESV

And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ,

John 3:16 ESV

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Yahweh, Yeshua & Ruach Pharmacy Instructions:

A. Pay attention to the Doctor's Instructions:

My child, attend to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them and healing to their flesh(being). (Proverbs 4:20-22)

Note: God is our Attending Physician and we must attend to his prescription (His Word)

B. Believe the medicine will work:

Therefore, I tell you, whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. (Mark 11:24)

Note: God requires two things of us for faith to grow; good spiritual soil (our spirit) and watering (our being in the Word). Then the fruit will be produced because God has put everything necessary in the seed.

C. Don't take expired medicine:

Our faith needs to be current and up-to-date. Having been faithful in the past was fine. But our faith needs to be contemporary, current and lived today.

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. (Hebrews 11:1) (key word – “Now”)

D. God's medicine must be taken internally (not topically):

Let them (my words) *not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart.* (Proverbs 4: 21)

We have to get the Word in our hearts and minds for full benefits and effectiveness

I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you. (Psalm 119:11)

E. You must not skip doses:

Keep them (your words) *within your heart* (...Proverbs 4:21)

Give us this day our daily bread (your Word, your presence) (Matthew 6:11)

F. Give them (God's Words) time to work:

Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh. (Proverbs 4: 21 & 22)

Because, in our life in Christ: ...*and as they went along, they were cleansed.* (Luke 17:14)

And, ...*but they who wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.* (Isaiah 40:31)
