- Check or payment must be made to Redeemer Church (\$230) by April 14th

Because Super Summer heavily relies on the consistency of meeting in a small group with students from all over the state, their leadership board has asked us to communicate that if a participant plan to attend Super Summer, **they must plan to attend the whole week**. Only in emergency situations do they allow students to leave and return to camp.

A few students have expressed interest in going this year, so we have put together this process and it is a quick turn-around. For next summer, you will be notified of these expectations in the Fall, I simply wanted to make you aware of this opportunity if this was something you or your child may be interested in. Super Summer has played an incredibly influential part in my life as a student, leader, and minister. I am so looking forward to what He will do with our students!
