2. Do you believe that the Bible is without error? Why or why not?


3. Why did Machen call the Bible "the very Magna Charta of Christian liberty"? What kind of liberty does it give people?


WEEK TEN OUTLINE: "THE BIBLE"



CHAPTER SYNOPSIS


"The Bible is not the only place where God reveals Himself. It is the only place, though, where He reveals the message of salvation. The Bible tells us what Jesus did and why He did it; it is the foundation of Christianity and its doctrines. Since it is inspired by the Holy Spirit, it contains no errors. It is trustworthy. Liberals often called the Bible into question. They doubted its historical accuracy and denied its inspiration. They appealed instead to their experience or "Christian consciousness." This means, Machen wrote, that the foundation of liberalism was human emotions.


Part I – The Study of Biblical Inerrancy

Darwin's, On the Origin of Species, sparked the debate that has never ended.



What we believe about the Bible is critical. There are really only three options...




Hopefully, you've seen Inerrancy in a new and simplified way.
