Why is membership important?

What is a membership commitment to Redeemer?

- First, a committed member is a Christian who has accepted Jesus' gift of salvation and eternal resurrection, and then has been baptized as evidence and testimony of their commitment to follow Him as a disciple.
- The commitment to being a part of the local church includes a commitment to follow Jesus Christ. This is evident through regular participation and service at Redeemer's gathering and worship services, a willingness to serve where needed, and having involvement in fellowship with other members of the church body through a small group, equipping classes, Bible studies, and members' meetings.
- A membership commitment includes the responsibility to notify Redeemer's leadership if, at any time, I can no longer commit as a church member or if I have any questions, comments, or concerns regarding Redeemer San Angelo.
- It is also important to have read and become aware of the Redeemer's Core Doctrinal statements.
- A membership commitment includes a willingness to join with the other members of Redeemer
 in committing your life patterns, abilities and resources to contribute to the vision, culture, and
 discipleship strategy of Redeemer San Angelo.
