Q. 170: How do worthy participants feed upon Christ's body and blood?

A. Christ's body and blood are not physically or bodily present in the bread and wine. However, they are spiritually present to the faith of the receiver just as truly and really as the elements are physically present. Worthy communicants feed on him spiritually.

Q. 171: How should people prepare before coming to the Lord's Supper?

A. Participants should examine themselves regarding whether they are in Christ, their sins, their knowledge, faith, repentance, love for God and others, and their desire for new obedience. They should renew these graces through serious meditation and fervent prayer.

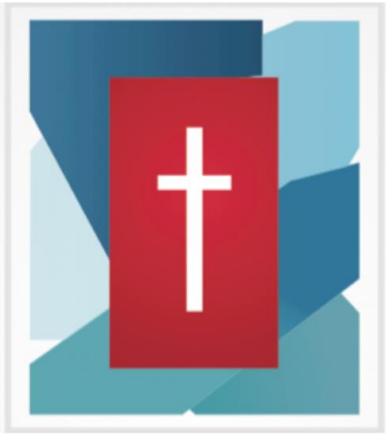
- Pastor Horne is preaching an expository sermon series on Paul's epistle to the **Romans**.
