Song of Gathering and Preparation

We prepare our hearts, and bodies for worship by singing about the God we serve.

Hosanna

Call to Worship: Luke 19:28-41

We read God's Word, the Bible, together. It reminds us of who God is and what He expects from us.

And when he had said these things, he went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. When he drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount that is called Olivet, he sent two of the disciples, saying, "Go into the village in front of you, where on entering you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever yet sat. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say this: 'The Lord has need of it.'" So those who were sent went away and found it just as he had told them. And as they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?" And they said, "The Lord has need of it." And they brought it to Jesus, and throwing their cloaks on the colt, they set Jesus on it...

...And as he rode along, they spread their cloaks on the road. As he was drawing near--already on the way down the Mount of Olives--the whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" And some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, rebuke your disciples." He answered, "I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out..." And when he drew near and saw the city, he wept over it.

Song of Adoration

We respond to God's invitation with songs of praise. These songs are designed to draw our attention to the wonder and glory of God.

Prayer of Adoration and Confession

We pray together, praising God for who He really is (Adoration) and admitting our inability to live up to what He expects of us (Confession).

Confession of Sin: "Continual Repentance" Valley of Vision

Leader: O God of grace, you have imputed our sins to our substitute and have imputed his righteousness to us, clothing us with a bridegroom's robe, decking us with jewels of holiness.

Congregation: But in our Christian walk we are still in rags; our best prayers are stained with sin; our penitential tears impure; even our confessions of wrong aggravate our sin.

Leader: We need to repent of our repentance; we need our tears to be washed. We have no robe to cover our sins, no loom to weave our own righteousness.

Congregation: We are always standing clothed in filthy garments and by grace are always receiving a change of raiment, for You always justify the ungodly...

ALL: Grant that we may never lose sight of the exceeding sinfulness of sin, the exceeding righteousness of salvation, the exceeding glory of Christ, the exceeding beauty of holiness, the exceeding wonder of grace. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon: Exodus 34:5-8

We read God's Word together and are reminded that grace and mercy are freely given to all who have faith in Jesus Christ.

The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation."

Song of Praise and Celebration

Our response to God's free grace is celebratory worship. We express our praise to God for who He is and what He has done to save us

Sacrament of Communion

Proclamation of God's Word: Page 940 in Pew Bible

A small portion of God's Word is explained to us and applied to our own lives.

22 For there is no distinction: 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. 26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. 27 Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith.
