DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS: PRIMING THE PUMP

[Fasting] reveals the measure of food's mastery over us — or television or computers or whatever we submit to again and again to conceal the weakness of our hunger for God. HEAR THE GOOD NEWS:

The Point: You were made to crave so much more than the world has to offer. Fasting sharpens and strengthens your godly affections as you long to be satisfied in God alone.

EMBRACE THE GOOD NEWS:

- What was your big takeaway from Sunday's message?
- Read Matthew 6:16-18
- According to this passage, what does fasting teach us about God?
- What does fasting teach us about ourselves?
- Why are people tempted to fast for the wrong motives?
- What are good motives for fasting?

LIVE THE GOOD NEWS:

- How does this passage impact the way that you live out the Good News in your home and in your relationships with friends and family?
- Parents: How can you model these truths to your kids and help them to understand these complex concepts?
- How does it impact the way that you weave the thread of the gospel as you interact with your church family? In our local community? To the ends of the earth?

PROCLAIM HIS EXCELLENCIES

Based on 1 Peter 2:9, consider sharing what God is doing in your life in 2016 by writing a brief testimony using the materials provided on the back counter and placing it in the jar hanging on the back wall.
