HEAR THE GOOD NEWS: Psalm 1

THE POINT: We pray to a worthy king - to know his glory and to make it known in all the earth.

PRAY:

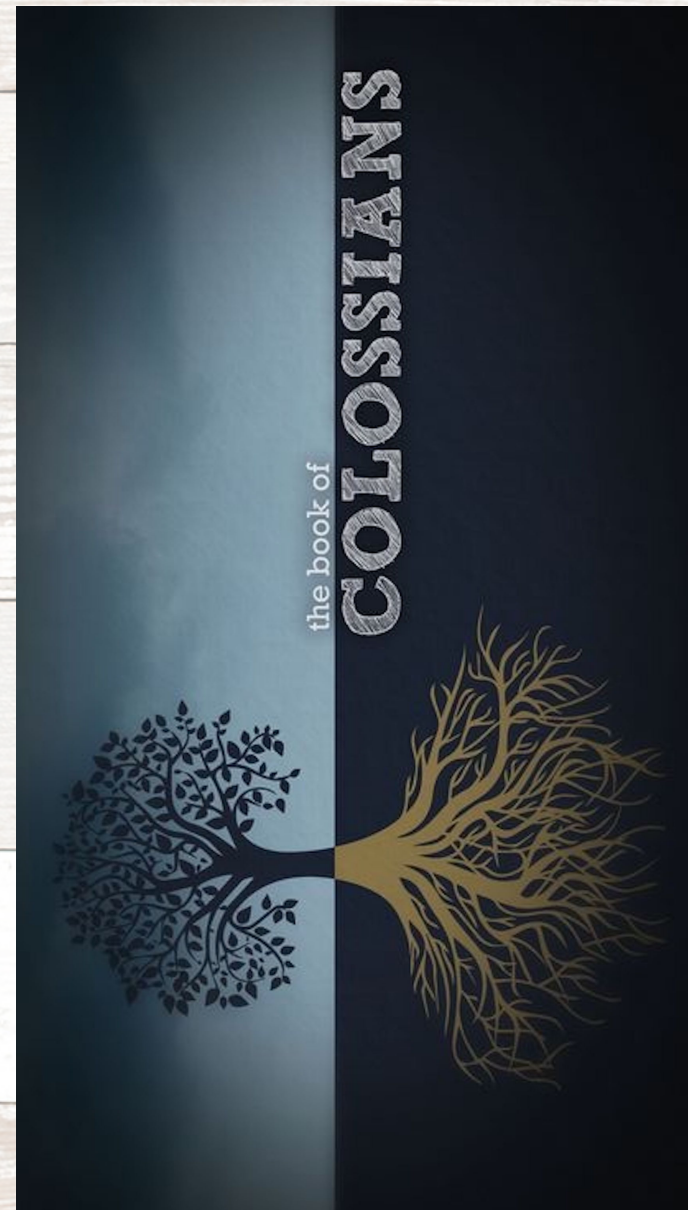
1. Read Psalm 1 or any other scripture of your choosing. This week's discipleship group primer is more about actually praying than studying!
2. What does this passage teach about God? (His commands, his expectations, his characteristics, his desires)
 - a. Worship God as you pray in light of this passage.
3. What does this passage teach about man in his natural, unspiritual state?
 - a. Confess, repent, and be thankful in prayer in light of who God is.
4. Discuss the question: in light of who God is and who I am, how should we pray?
 - a. Pray for yourself, the church, and the world.

PROCLAIM HIS EXCELLENCIES

Based on 1 Peter 2:9, consider sharing what God is doing in your life in 2016 by writing a brief testimony using the materials provided on the back counter and placing it in the jar hanging on the back wall.

START READING THE BIBLE IN 2016
