

Discover Revolve Primer

Revolve may look differently than other churches you have heard of or attended in the past. That's because at Revolve, we don't think the church is a building or an event, but a group of people following God and living a life that revolves around Jesus. We are primarily a training facility - a place where you can be equipped to weave the gospel into every area of your life. We intentionally strive to be light on events and programs because Christianity is not a program, but a way of life. Rather than hosting a variety of events at our church throughout the week, we prefer that you are involved in the world around you and bringing Christ with you as you go. We call this "Decentralized Ministry" and it is the driving force behind why we do what we do the way we do it.

Consider looking at Matthew 28:16-20; Acts 1:1-11;

Sermon Summary:

- Our Purpose: to glorify God by making disciples who make disciples of all nations.
- Our Passion: to mobilize a movement of disciple-makers who weave the gospel into every area of their lives.
- Our Personality: to be a decentralized group of disciples who are committed to hearing, embracing, and living the good news.

Discipleship Group Questions:

1. Has there ever been a time in your life when you felt like you were floundering and without purpose? What did you do?
2. Where do other people direct their passion as they search for purpose and meaning in life?
3. The gospel invites us to join something that God is already doing, and has been doing since long before we were born. How is being invited to join a mission with purpose different from seeking out a mission or purpose?
4. In your own words, explain why Revolve functions the way that it functions. In other words, why do we do what we do the way that we do it?

Action Step:

We exist to make you successful in living the life God has called you to live. As such, we want to equip you to weave the gospel into every area of your life. Your purpose is woven and inseparably from the gospel, but the role you have to play is unique to you.

Over the next month, write out your own purpose, passion, and personality statements (or your "mission statement" so to speak). What do you want your life to be about? How has God

equipped you to bring the gospel into your family, your work, your world? Pray for guidance and chew on this deep concept with your group.
