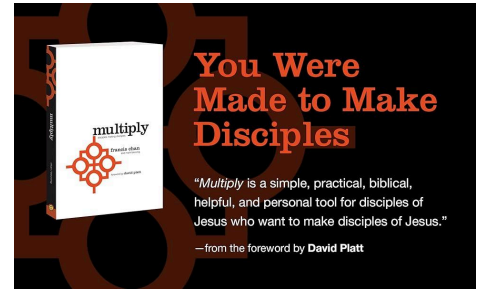


Over the next **6 months**, Revolve is encouraging our whole congregation to work through the book **Multiply** together.
