



9th-12th Grade Technology Check-out and or Personally Owned Computer Policy

To provide reliable computers and to promote godly usage of the computers, the following policy must be read, understood, and signed by the student and parent with every intention of complying with the policy.

- 1) The laptops are the property of Riverbend Academy, if leased from Riverbend Academy.
- 2) If any repair to or replacement of a laptop is required due to student misuse or negligence, the student and his/her parent(s) must completely cover the cost of repair or replacement, if leased from Riverbend Academy.
- 3) Laptop usage is monitored and tracked and may be remotely accessed at any time, or if Riverbend Academy representative asks to inspect or see history of student's computer, said student will not refuse request.
- 4) Students are not permitted to download anything to the laptops.
- 5) Students are not permitted to access any iTunes account(s) or social media accounts on the laptops.
- 6) Laptops may be confiscated at any time for any reason deemed needful by Riverbend Academy teachers and/or administration. Violations of any of the above restrictions will result in confiscation of the laptop and revocation of laptop privileges and access, if leased from Riverbend Academy. If privately owned, loss of technology privilege for infractions may occur. Said consequences will be determined by administration.
- 7) If an infraction occurs, and the need is warranted, the student may be asked to return the computer or have a loss of privilege of bringing the computer to school for a length of time to be determined by administration. If deemed necessary to return the computer, all original contents must be neat and in working order. Original chargers, etc. must be replaced by students and/or parents if damaged or broken.
- 8) Personal computers used at the school are NOT entitled to any maintenance, support, troubleshooting, or installed software from the Academy. The Academy will provide access to the internet via a guest Wi-Fi. Said computers will be capable of printing via direct USB cable or thumb drive for school assignments.

Parents, we exhort you to be intentional with and informed about your son's or daughter's use of the laptop. The world is dark, and sin abounds; with a few keystrokes and a couple of clicks, your child could see and even end up directly experiencing any manner of wickedness. Please help your child navigate this present darkness.
