Missionary Spotlight Myanmar Young Crusaders | MYC is an indigenous church-planting, leader development, and evangelistic mission in the Southeast Asian nation of Myanmar, and a ministry partner of REPC. MYC's leader, Dr. Khin-Khin (Sharon) Moe, has been surveying the destruction and devastation dealt by the recent catastrophic earthquakes in her country. Many MYC church buildings and the homes of believers have been destroyed or severely damaged by the earthquakes, particularly in the northern areas of the country. We are grateful that no lives of our ministry partners have so far been reported lost, especially in light of the rising death toll. The ongoing civil war makes it even more challenging to determine the critical next steps in recovery.
