

Missionary Spotlight Eliya & Jyoti Pradhan | Eliya and Jyoti founded and direct an evangelistic and discipleship training ministry for children, parents, and Christian workers in Nepal, Northeast India, and Bhutan. They have a team of more than a dozen men and women who work with them in this growing ministry. Theirs is the only indigenous ministry in Nepal whose primary aim is to share the gospel with children. They conduct rallies and Bible schools throughout Nepal. They also produce a radio program for children. When children come to know Jesus, God often draws entire families to faith as other family members see the difference Jesus makes in the children's lives. Recently, their ministry conducted a Christian music concert in southern Nepal, attended by more than 5000 participants, many of whom placed their trust in Christ for the first time.
