We confess we have elevated ourselves in pride and have belittled others In criticism. We have diminished and disrespected people with words and deeds. Teach us to walk in love.

Your steadfast love endures forever, but we have Insisted on our own way. We have been irritable and resentful.

We confess we have been selfish in our thinking and demanding in our expectations. We quickly become angry and slowly let go of bitterness. Teach us to walk in love.
