Sermon Discussion Questions: Numbers 13:1-33 April 15, 2018

- 1. What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
- 2. What various questions do we tend to ask when we face an unknown situation in the future? What does this reveal about what we value?
- 3. What seems to be the different convictions that drive the different interpretation between the spies who returned with a bad report and those that returned with a good report? (Numbers 13:25-33 & Deuteronomy 1:29-30)
- 4. How should the promise from Exodus 3:17 and Exodus 6:4-8 have encouraged them to have faith in the midst of their fear?

5. What circumstances are you facing right now that stir your fears? Write out those fears associated with the circumstances. The scripture tells us in 2 Corinthians 1:20 "For all the promises of God find their Yes in him (Jesus). That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory." Meditate on one or more of the promises of God toward you who trust in Jesus (Ephesians 3:19-20, Matthew 6:31-33, Isaiah 46:4, Psalm 34:19). Pray the Lord will help you trust in faith as you face your fears.
