Sermon Discussion Questions: Numbers 16 $\,$ May 6^{th} , 2018

1.	What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2.	Read Numbers 16:2-3. What seems to be the reason for this rebellion of Korah? Why does our present culture struggle so much with the exclusivity of Christianity?
3.	What area of life do you find yourself acting jealous of someone else's position and opportunities? What does this reveal about what you love and long to have?
4.	Read Numbers 16:4-5 How does Moses initially respond to this rebellion and how does this model to us how to respond to false accusations? What do Moses' words about God and actions to God reveal about God's character in confusing situations?
5.	How does believing that Jesus alone is the adequate mediator between God and man (1 Timothy 2:3-6) motivate us to share the gospel with family, friends, neighbors and coworkers? Why is Jesus the only adequate mediator compared to Jewish priests or any other religious priest, prophets, or teachers (Hebrews 7:26-28)?
6.	Read Numbers 16:20-22 and 16:44-48. In what ways does Moses demonstrate mercy in his role as the mediator? How does this merciful act of intercession point to Jesus' intercession for us which guarantees our salvation (Hebrews 7:25)?
