1.	What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2.	What does your prayer life reveal about your own struggle to trust God's rule as King? What particular desires are you wrestling with in prayer before God now?
3.	What guidelines does God provide for relating to the needs of the sojourner (Leviticus 19:9-10, 33-34, Deuteronomy 10:14-18)? How might this inform our response to asylum seeking immigrants?
4.	Why should we be cautious to view God as King exclusively?
5.	Even though King Balak sought to curse Israel, the Lord was determined to bless. Read Psalm 89:28-37. How does God relate to our sin and what ensures his ongoing commitment to us even though we sin?
