1. What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2. Reading Ephesians 2:1-3 what various influences hindered our ability to know and pursue God through Christ and keep us trapped in sin? What particular corrupted cultural influences specifically captured your attention before coming to Christ?
3. Read Romans 1:18-25. What has happened to the desires and values of the human heart? How do these desires affect our pursuit of truth and God?
4. There is probably no other section in the Bible that displays God's grace more clearly than Ephesians 2:3-4. God saves a dead people devastated by their sin and makes us alive and fully identified with Jesus and his life. What motivates God to save and bring us back to life in Christ? In what ways do we see God's grace displayed in this section of Ephesians 2:1-9?
5. How does regeneration help us overcome our fear of sharing the Gospel with people that seem too hardened against it and confront our prejudice over certain people we believe should not be saved because of their life decisions?
