3.	Read Revelation 21:3, 21:22, and 22:3. What do these verses reveal about the presence of God in the new creation? What might worship be like in the new creation if the whole world is a temple?
4.	Why do we have a tendency to put ultimate allegiance and hope in specific leaders of corporations, countries, and churches? According to Psalm 146:1-4 why does the Psalmist warn us to not put ultimate allegiance and hope in authorities?
5.	According to Psalm 146:5-10, what is God doing in his leadership as King over creation and why is he more worthy of our hope and allegiance as King?
