

Sermon Discussion Questions: 1 Peter 2:4-8

March 24th, 2019

1. What in the sermon encouraged you, comforted you, challenged you, or informed you?
2. Throughout this text we see that Christ is the sure foundation of the Christian life, that He is our cornerstone. In 1 Corinthians 3:10-15, Paul talks about ministry with other people using a similar building metaphor. How should we minister to other people according to this building metaphor and in what sense is Christ the foundation of our life?
3. Paul says that those who trust in Christ as their cornerstone will never be put to shame. Read the following promises about Christ and his salvation work: Hebrews 7:23-25, Romans 8:32-39, John 10:27-30. How do these promises assure us that we will not be put to shame or somehow lose our security in Christ?
4. What are inadequate foundations upon which people build their life and why are they uncertain and insecure? Why is it that people stumble and fall if they reject Christ as their foundation?
5. Peter says that the church is a building created to “offer spiritual sacrifices to God through Jesus Christ,” or in other words to worship God. How can our whole life be an expression of worship? How might you be able to worship God through your workplace, school, or daily routines? (See Colossians 3:17, 23 & 1 Corinthians 10:31).
