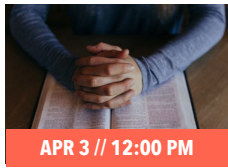




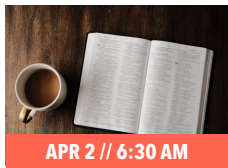

Join us in the John Knox Room from noon to 1:00 pm for a time of prayer. This month we will focus our prayer on the lost. All are welcome.

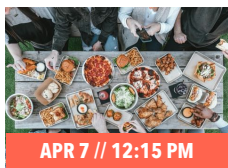

Men meet weekly on Tuesday mornings in the Fellowship Hall with hot coffee, good fellowship and Bible study. This study is open to all men and their friends in the community.

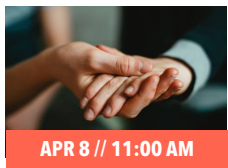
