### Day One | Philippians 2:1-4

Questions: How does our love for Jesus unify us?

What are some practical ways you can count someone else as more significant than yourself and meet the needs of others?

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## [Week Two] Micah 6

### Day One | Micah 6:1-4

Questions: Why does God bring His complaint to the mountains & hills?  
God brought Israel out of slavery in Egypt - what has He done for you? What has He saved you from?

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### Day Two | Micah 6:5 (Numbers 22-25)

Questions: Micah 6:5 references events from Numbers 22-25. Read through those chapters. What was happening?  
How do those events relate to this passage in Micah?

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### Day Three | Micah 6:6-8

Questions: Micah asks what extravagant offering he could bring to God to be accepted. What do you think God wants from you?  
What does God require?(v8) How are you doing in those areas?

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## Day Four | Micah 6:9-12

Questions: What are the sins of the nation that God calls out?

Do those same sins occur today?

Do these things break your heart?

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## Day Five | Micah 6:13-16(1 Kings 16:25-26;1 Kings 16:30-33)

Questions: Have you experienced any of the curse that God describes here?

Who were Omri & Ahab? (from the 1 Kings passages)

Are there sins of the past that we're repeating today?

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## [Week Three] Daniel 3; Matthew 22:15-22; Romans 13:1-7

### Day One | Daniel 3:1-7

Questions: Israel was in exile and the King set up an idol of gold & commanded them to bow before it in worship. Are there ways that you feel pressured today to do what you know is wrong?

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### Day Two | Daniel 3:8-18

Questions: What impresses you about their response?  
Do you think they lacked faith in their reply?  
Is God calling you to take a stand & trust in Him today?

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### Day Three | Daniel 3:19-30

Questions: Did God rescue them from the fire?  
Who was in the fire with them?  
Have you experienced God's presence in a trial?

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## Day Four | Matthew 22:15-22

Questions: Ultimately, does Jesus say they should pay the tax?  
How does this relate to our government today?  
Should we obey the laws of our government?

Questions: Why does v1 say that we should obey governing authorities?  
Is it ever right to disobey government? How do we know?  
Are there areas where you are wrestling with obedience?

## [Week Five] 2 Corinthians 5

### Day One | 2 Corinthians 5:1-5

Questions: Do you look forward to your heavenly body?

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## [Week Six] Ephesians 4

### Day One | Ephesians 4:1-8

Questions: What does it look like to be eager to maintain unity?  
Which of the “one” statements stands out the most to you?  
Which of God’s gifts do you value the most?

What danger is there in an immature faith?

Questions: To whom do you need to show more kindness today? Who needs your forgiveness? What will you do to make peace? What is our motivation for forgiveness?
