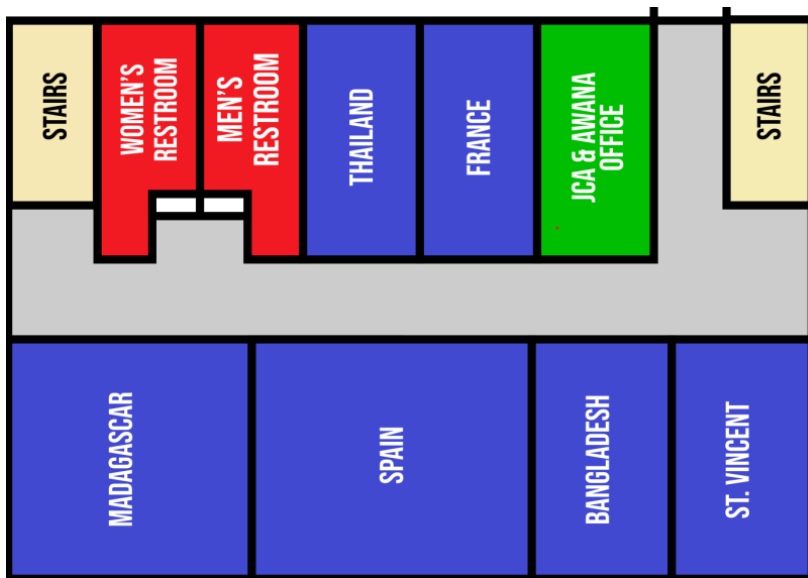

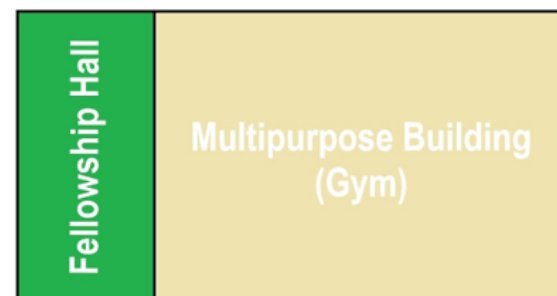
Cambodia Village Outreach

Goals: Students understand Matthew 28 and the difference Between Cheap and costly grace
Students receive firsthand knowledge of different cultures and governments
Long-term partnerships established between a missionary and a JCA Class

Overview:

Missionaries will be with JCA from 9am to 2pm on the 17th and 18th of September. On Thursday, we will have a special Missionary Chapel to start the day. During chapel, we will introduce all the missionaries to the students. The goal will be a quick 5-minute introduction of all the missionaries with a focus on why they do what they do. After Chapel, the missionaries will be sent to different classrooms to provide firsthand information on World Literature, World History, Geography, Earth and Space Science, and government. Additionally, HS students will prepare questions about the different government types in Togo, Cambodia, India, and Eastern Europe. The AWANA missionary will be tied into Gym programs with K5 - 5th grade.

On Friday, BOAM and AWANA missionaries will partner with Mr. Jeffers and Mrs. Duncan during their Bible Classes to go over the principles of Matthew 28. Students will be asked to compare cheap vs. costly grace utilizing an article about Dietrich Bonhoeffer during the class. Mr. Mock will partner with Science and History teachers to provide additional insight into Physical Science and Current Culture in Eastern Europe. Mr. Archer and Mr. Huon will be in the gym where we would like to play games that are unique to Togo and Cambodia.
