We continue to sponsor underprivileged children to attend one week of summer camp, those who live in regions or situations and can benefit from it. This year, we connected with two new camps in two different provinces. The camp directors were overcome with gratitude and called it a miracle, for our assistance in helping these children and indicated there are many waiting for this opportunity. However, we can only sponsor what we have budgeted for. With your support, and considering the increased cost per child, this year we will be sponsoring 25 children from three different provinces and involving four different camps. More than half of these children live in remote or urban areas of northern Canada.

Our prayer team continues to meet every Tuesday. We received an amazing answer to prayer from a former field missionary couple this week. God is working through our mission in many ways and the good news of His love and power is being felt by many. Join us for prayer or send your items and let us believe God for your situation too.
