We rent our church facility to local groups in order to bring in additional income to pay our mortgage and utilities. Although it does require more time dedicated to setup and cleaning for the groups, the financial help is tremendous. Also, it brings in people outside of the faith into our facility where we worship with the hopes of them returning to join us in a worship service. Every opportunity for invitations is utilized!



Steve Bray (Director) and several members of Mile One Mission traveled to the USA this month to continue raising money for our ministries. The hope is to have team members for all the church plants and then also begin an additional four more plants in the next year or two. Fundraising is a behind the scenes part of church planting, but a very necessary one that pastors must anticipate and understand fully when going into the field. God is good and has blessed us in many ways this year. I am planning a trip next year as well to raise money for Northern Cross for facility improvement projects.
