

IV. ... for He will save His people from their sins

- He Saves from the PENALTY of Sin – Matthew 1:21

“... you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins.”

- He Saves from the POWER of Sin

“To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood” – Rev 1:5b

“Sin shall not have dominion over you...” – Rom 6:14

- He Saves from the SEPARATION of Sin – 2 Cor. 5:18-19; Rom. 5:10; Col. 1:21-22

FROM GOD - “Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.”

FROM EACH OTHER - “¹⁶and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity... in whom the whole building, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.” - Ephesians 2:16, 21-22

- He Gives us ACCESS into His presence – Eph. 2:18; Heb. 10:19-22

¹⁸ For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father.

- He Lives in US – (Saved in His life)

“For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.” – Rom. 5:10

V. We Experience Immanuel as we Experience Christ in us

- When we gather in his Name (with one another) – Matt. 18:20, Heb 2:12; Col 3:16

“For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

- Through His faithful and unfailing presence with us.

Jn 14:18; Mt 28:20; Heb 13:5; Gen 28:15; Dt 31:8; Jos 1:5; 1 Sam 12:22; 1Chr 28:20; Ps 37:25, 28, Ps 139:7-8; Isa 41:10,17

- Through His life in us and our life in Him

“To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.” – Col 1:27

- In His Name - The name of Jesus – Philippians 2:9-11

I. Shall call his name... Immanuel, God with us

- - **Isaiah 7:14** - "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel." (~ 700 yrs. BC)
- - **Matthew 1:21-23, 25b** - "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: "*Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,*" which is translated, "God with us."... And he called His name JESUS.

II. His name will be called

- - **Isaiah 9:6-7** - "For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this."
- - **Luke 1:31-33** - " And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS."

³² He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³ And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

- **Luke 2:11, 21** – "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."... "And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called JESUS, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb."

III. God has given him the name... The name of Jesus

- **Philippians 2:9-11** - "Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."
- **Acts 4:12** - "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."
