(Jesus has cleansed, called, and chosen us - and He is coming)

## Precious Promises Granted and Reminders to Partake of Them

2 Pet 1:2-4 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord; seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

**2 Pet 1:12-13,15** Therefore, I will always be ready to **remind you of these things**, even though you *already* know *them*, and have been established in the truth which is present with *you*. I consider it right, as long as I am in this *earthly* dwelling, to **stir you up by way of reminder**... I will also be diligent that at any time after my departure you will be able to **call these things to mind**.

### Cleansed (Redeemed)

1 Pet 1:18-19 Redeemed to, once for all, rescue us from a life devoid of truth, force, success, or result knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

1 Pet 2:24-25 Redeemed to heal our continual straying by causing us to return, once for all, to God and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed. For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

1 Pet 3:18 Redeemed to once for all bring us to God and establish our relationship with Him in Spirit For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the Spirit;

#### Called

1 Pet 1:15 Called to live a life consistent with God's holy nature - as a promise, not a demand but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; because it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

1 Pet 2:9 Called out of darkness, into His marvelous light, to proclaim His excellencies
But you are A CHOSEN RACE, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR God's
OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of
darkness into His marvelous light;

1 Pet 2:21b-23 Called, while suffering, to keep entrusting ourselves to God and receive His grace But if when you do what is right and suffer for it you patiently endure it, this finds favor (is grace) with God. For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, WHO COMMITTED NO SIN, NOR WAS ANY DECEIT FOUND IN HIS MOUTH; and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously;

- 1 Pet 3:8-9 Called to bless people, and to inherit a blessing, in all our relationships
  To sum up, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kind hearted, and humble in spirit; not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing.
- 1 Pet 5:9-10 Called, through suffering and the operation of God's grace, to eternal glory
  But resist him (your adversary, the devil), firm in your faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world. After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.
- 2 Pet 1:2-3 Called, by the glory and excellence of God and Jesus our Lord

### Chosen

1 Pet 1:1-2 Chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father

Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who reside as aliens, scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, who are **chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father**, by the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood: May grace and peace be yours in the fullest measure.

1 Pet 2:9-10 Chosen to proclaim the excellencies of Christ

But you are **A CHOSEN RACE**, A royal PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR *God's* OWN POSSESSION, so that you may **proclaim the excellencies of Him** who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

1 Pet 5:12b-13 Chosen together with other believers

I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it! She who is in Babylon, **chosen together with you**, sends you greetings,

Coming

- 2 Pet 1:16 Coming and seen in majesty, as a preview and a promise of His return in His kingdom For we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.
- 2 Pet 3:3-4 Coming, yet keeping all things as they were, despite mockings of lusting people Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the **promise of His coming**? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all continues just as it was from the beginning of creation."
- 2 Pet 3:9 Coming, but patient because of His desire that all to come to repentance The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.
- 2 Pet 3:11b-13 Coming, but leaving us His promise of the new, and righteous, heavens and earth what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God ... But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.
