A Living Sacrifice

- 12 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a *living sacrifice*, *holy* and *acceptable* to God, which is your spiritual worship. 2 *Do not be conformed* to this world, but be *transformed* by the renewal of your mind, that by testing *you may discern* what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
- 3 For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to <u>think of himself more highly than he ought to think</u>, but to think with <u>sober judgment</u>, each according to the measure of faith that God has assigned. 4 For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, 5 so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. 6 Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if <u>prophecy</u>, in proportion to our faith; 7 <u>if service</u>, <u>in our serving</u>; the one who <u>teaches</u>, <u>in his teaching</u>; 8 the one who <u>exhorts</u>, <u>in his exhortation</u>; the one who contributes, in <u>generosity</u>; the one who <u>leads</u>, <u>with zeal</u>; the one who does acts of <u>mercy</u>, <u>with cheerfulness</u>.
- 9 Let <u>love be genuine</u>. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. 10 <u>Love one</u> another with <u>brotherly affection</u>. Outdo one another in <u>showing honor</u>. 11 <u>Do not be slothful in zeal</u>, be <u>fervent in spirit</u>, <u>serve the Lord</u>. 12 <u>Rejoice in hope</u>, be <u>patient in tribulation</u>, be <u>constant in prayer</u>. 13 <u>Contribute to the needs</u> of the saints and <u>seek to show hospitality</u>.
- 14 <u>Bless those who persecute you</u>; bless and <u>do not curse</u> them. 15 <u>Rejoice with</u> those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. 16 <u>Live in harmony</u> with one another. Do not be haughty, <u>but associate with the lowly</u>. Never be wise in your <u>own sight</u>. 17 <u>Repay no one evil for evil</u>, but give thought to <u>do what is honorable</u> in the sight of all. 18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, <u>live peaceably with</u> <u>all</u>. 19 Beloved, <u>never avenge yourselves</u>, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord." 20 To the contrary, "if <u>your enemy is hungry, feed him</u>; if <u>he is thirsty, give him something to drink</u>; for by so doing you will heap burning coals on his head." 21 Do not be <u>overcome by</u> evil, but overcome evil with good.
