# Why Kids4Truth?

Kids4Truth is intense truth for young minds. This biblical education program encompasses verse memorization, biblical homework, and Bible lessons. Kids are learning foundational doctrines straight from the Bible in a fun and engaging way. It is designed to intentionally teach children biblical truth about the character of God while holding them accountable to Scripture memorization each week. The bar is set high so that children are encouraged to work diligently. They are rewarded with Bible bucks to spend in the award store twice a year, as well as patches that are earned based on the verses they memorize. This program is geared to encourage, equip, and engage them with biblical truth.

Many curriculums teach how we should live and what God expects, but many fail to lay a foundation of *Who God is*. Kids4Truth curriculum views all of life through a God-focused paradigm – that is, "it's all about God!" (See Romans 11:33-36.)

The program consists of 12 themes, divided between 2 books. Children go through 1 book / 6 themes per year. Each of the 4 classes is learning the same themes, just at different levels. As the kids get older, they will repeat the cycle at a deeper level. They begin memorizing a short verse and answer to each catechism questions, and as they get older, they memorize longer answers as well as full passages. Our goal is that the kids would hide God's Word in their heart as they learn more about His character.

Everything in Kids4Truth is purposefully planned to further enrich what they are already learning. Our club night begins with the 3 oldest classes meeting together for prayer, singing. and announcements. The songs they sing are doctrinally rich hymns that correspond to the themes they are learning. Then, they will head outside for a fun game time. After the kids expend a bit of energy, they will go to their age appropriate class and be given the opportunity to recite the verses they memorized to their leaders. While children take turns reciting verses, their class leader will be engaging the class by reading through a biblically-focused chapter book, leading a discussion about the homework questions, or facilitating a special activity that corresponds to a theme night. After class time, we come together as a group again where we have a teacher present our weekly lesson in an age appropriate, engaging manner. We end the night with a celebration of awards earned. Every aspect of Kids4Truth is intentional!

# Here is an example of what the students will learn at all 4 levels.

During this 2 year cycle, the children will learn 120 distinct catechism questions and answers with their corresponding Scripture. As they graduate into the older classes and repeat this cycle, their knowledge of these truths will deepen! A few of the questions change over the years, but for the most part, they stay the same. The answers are developed at a deeper level for every age group, and longer passages of Scripture are included.

Below is the very first question asked, as it is developed across the different levels:

The children learn these 120 essential truths 3-4 times during their Kids 4 Truth session years. This is an effort to give them the best possible learning experience, and solidify these truths in their hearts.

# **Kids4Truth Program Information**

K4T is a biblical education program for kids that encompasses memorization, biblical homework, and Bible lessons. All the elements of K4T are connected: the homework, memory work, and Bible lessons all work together to reinforce the same truths. Even the songs we sing are related to the theme in which we are studying!

Children have many opportunities to earn awards, which include Bible bucks that they get to spend twice a year at our award store, and special patches!

# **Class names and grade levels:**

- Discoverers (Green shirts: PreK Kindergarten / 4-5yo)
- Developers (Red shirts: 1st 2nd grade)
- Detectives (Yellow shirts: 3rd 4th grade)
- Defenders (Blue shirts: 5th 6th grade)

# **Homework & Scripture Memorization:**

Each child has a K4T book (the official term is "Truthbook"). Every Truthbook has 6 themes, and each theme is divided into 10 units. We go through 2 units each week at K4T.

Homework consists of a reading section, several questions to answer, and some thought-provoking questions that you should be helping your child to think through. In the yellow box is the question, answer, and verse that kids are asked to memorize.


#### **Terms for Level 4**

**Q&A Unit** = Mission


**Review 1** = Tournament Training **Review 2** = Final Tournament

The unit begins with the title and ends with a place for a servant's signature (after the verse has been recited). Doctrinal theme and unit number are located above the unit title.




# **Tournament Training Page =** Review Q&A #1-5 from doctrinal theme




The child memorizes and recites everything in this color box.



By reciting Q&A #1-5 or Q&A #6-10 at the end of a theme, children can earn a special "5 in a row" patch.



#### **Awards & Patches**

There are 3 types of rewards that kids earn: Bible bucks, patches, and special pins that are awarded at the end of the year.

Kids have the opportunity to earn Bible bucks every Wednesday night! They earn \$1 for:

- coming to Kids4Truth
- bringing their Bible
- bringing their Truthbook
- bringing their K4T bag
- wearing their K4T shirt
- reciting verses (\$1 for every verse recited)

They get the chance to spend their Bible bucks 2x a year in our award store during Christmastime and at the end of the year.

Kids earn patches by reciting verses. In each theme, there are 3 opportunities for your child to earn a regular patch. If your child is especially eager to learn, they can also earn an additional 2 patches by taking on extra work.

- If they recite verses 1-2 of a theme they receive Patch 1 (a special "Theme" patch)
- If they recite verses 3-6 of a theme they receive Patch 2
- If they recite verses 7-10 of a theme they receive Patch 3
- Extra patch: 5 in a row
  - At the end of a theme, children have the opportunity to recite 5 verses in a row to earn the 5 in a row patch.
- Extra patch: Bonus
  - Every class (except the Discoverers) has extra bonus questions and answers. It gets harder with each class: in the Developers / Red, there is 1 bonus section. In the Detectives / Yellow, there are 2, and in the Defenders / Blue, there are 3. To earn the bonus patch, a child has to memorize every bonus Q&A in a theme. It is a *lot* of work.

At the end of the year, kids will also have the chance to receive a special pin that acknowledges their diligent work all year long.

- Gold Children must have memorized all 10 verses in each theme.
- Silver Children must earn at least 2 patches from each theme.
- Bronze Children must earn at least 1 patch from each theme.
