

Curriculum Explanation

Terms for Level 4

- Doctrinal Theme = Adventure
- Q&A Unit = Mission
- Review 1 = Tournament Training
- Review 2 = Final Tournament

Commentary: explains the teaching of the truth in this unit.

Primary Truth
The Bible is the only book that is God's Word to us. It is better and more important than all other books combined!

WHAT THIS DOCTRINE REVEALS ABOUT GOD
The purpose of this lesson is to help children understand that the Bible is the most special and important book ever written. The apostle Paul wrote in **1 Thessalonians 2:13**, "When you received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God." The Bible is important because it teaches us about God. He wants us to know who He is and what He wants us to do in this world. God has a perfect will for the whole world. We learn about Him and His will in the Bible.

• Children will gain a deeper appreciation for simply owning a Bible.
• Children will treat their Bibles with reverence and respect by not leaving them under their beds or in their family's vehicles.
• Children will grow in their gratitude toward the Lord, Who provided His Word.

Q1. What is the Bible?

A. The Bible is the only Book that is God's Word to us.

Q1. What is the Bible?

A. The Spirit of God helps us know that the Bible is God's Word.

Q3. How did God give us the Bible?
A. God gave holy men His words to write down. **2 Peter 1:21b** - "But holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost."

Q4. Does the Bible teach any lies?
A. No. God's Word is true because God tells only the truth.

Q5. What does the Bible teach us?
A. The Bible teaches what God wants us to believe and how He wants us to behave.

A. Yes. God's Word is good and true forever.

Q7. Why do we need the Bible?
A. We need the Bible to show us Who God is and how we can be close to Him.

Q8. How can we truly get to know God?
A. We get to know God by faith, which comes from hearing His Word.

Q9. What authority does the Bible have over us?
A. The Bible is our highest authority because it comes from God. **2 Timothy 3:16a** - "All scripture is given by inspiration of God."

Q10. How does God want us to feel about the Bible?
A. God wants us to love and believe the Bible.
