- 4. This week again also mark the words *righteous/ness and wicked*. I used light blue to shade over righteous and put a big R on it and for wicked you can draw a black cloud around the whole word. (Official Inductive symbols)
- 5. Write out below the Proverbs we find in these chapters on the Woman/Wife:
