On the Other Hand

Let me start by saying thank you to everyone who worked so hard to make our youth rally such a wonderful success. There were countless hours of planning, organization, purchasing, set up, cooking, cleaning, the list goes on and on. An event like this is so much greater than any one person, or even a committee. It takes a lot of coordination of a lot of different elements, and it would not be possible without the strong help of the entire church. Thank you for stepping up (not that there was any doubt).

But sometimes it's hard to bounce back from a weekend youth rally. Everyone is exhausted from the time and labor that went into serving. The mental strain of making sure everything was as good as it could be tends to linger for a while. By that I mean this: God is not so demanding, so stringent, so exacting that the worship we offer to Him should be a stressful event. Our worship to Him can be something that flows naturally from us to Him. In praise, in prayer, in reverence, in honor, and in glory, we can present ourselves before the throne of the Almighty in spirit and in truth, in complete confidence that our veneration is pleasing and acceptable to Him.

On the other hand, knowing how important worship is, what if we DID put as much effort into EVERY worship as we do for "special" events. Maybe we don't have to do all we did this past weekend (although cookies are appreciated at any time, TB; just saying), but Danny really hit the nail on the head this past Sunday during the Lord's supper: we have to make that walk to the cross every week. We HAVE to make that journey, and it's a hard road. If we can't make it to the cross, we haven't gone far enough.

New Contact System & Updating Information


