2020: What a Dramastic Year!

If you sat down a year ago and mapped out your plans for 2020, I will dare say that many if not most of those plans were for naught. Hopefully, though, we will learn and move on. Here are some lessons taken from 2020—and from James 4:13-17:

- "Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit";" (James 4:13, NKJV). James was not telling us to not make plans. He was, however, telling us not to make our plans without God. No matter what you were not able to do this year that you had planned,
- "whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away." (James 4:14). As if we needed this reminder, 2020 has underlined the frailty of human life.
- "Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that."" (James 4:15). I think, I hope, I pray that 2020 has caused us to pay closer attention to "what the Lord wills," and to realize that our will is of lesser significance. One of the greatest ways that has been demonstrated this year has been in the way we have worshiped. God's will: worship (see John 4:24; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Acts 20:7; Ephesians 5:19; et al.) Our will: sit in a comfy pew, have announcements, then 2 songs and a prayer. This year has bent our will to His will.
- "But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil." (James 4:16). Another thing 2020 has reminded us is that we are not in control, and that is actually a good thing. Knowing that His eyes are ever on us and His ears are always open is the most comforting news of the year (1 Peter 3:12).
- "Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin." (James 4:17). James (Price, not James the author of this book) mentioned yesterday in announcements words to the effect of, "We can't do what we did so we have to find what we can do." What a great reminder that there is still much to be done, and with God's will in charge, we can get it done!
