Ain't Going Back

There is a business establishment here in town that I just flat out do not enjoy patronizing. The products they sell are unique to here and excellent—there is absolutely no room for complaint in that area—but I do not appreciate the customer service. The staff is often curt, bordering on rude, not helpful at all, and just generally not pleasant to deal with. (That's my assessment. And no, I'm not telling you which establishment I am talking about, so don't even ask.) They don't have any idea how I feel about them. It's not like I'm going to tell them how I feel. That would be really awkward, for them and for me. And so, even though they offer something unique to this area, I do not go there unless I have to.

And that got me to thinking, Could this be Shady Acres?

Obviously I was talking about somewhere else, but do we really know how others see us? I mean, we think we're great. We know that we have something unique (the pure, unadulterated gospel of Jesus Christ).
