Worship

Worship. It literally means "to kiss one's hand to." It is praise, adoration, devotion, but at the same time it has to be done in the spirit of absolute humility of the lesser toward the greater. It is something that everyone CAN do if they so choose, but it has to be done in spirit and in truth (John 4:24). It is something that the church does, but that the primary responsibility for falls on the individual worshiper. It is something that strengthens us and that we gain from by giving to our God. This Sunday, March 13, our entire emphasis is going to be on worship. It will be our goal to be challenged, encouraged, edified and uplifted while giving our Lord and Creator the honor, reverence, dignity, and glory that He deserves.

NOTE::::Let's begin this discussion by pointing out that there are many, many things which are matters of expedience. In other words, the Bible may give us things to do but may be silent on how to accomplish those things. One thing that falls into that category is our order of worship. The Bible tells us what to do and what the early church did, but gives no indication as to when they did what. So being a matter of expediency, it is left up to us to decide. At the start of the pandemic we changed the order of our services. Communion was moved to after the sermon and the announcements were moved to the conclusion of services instead of at the beginning. The reasoning was very simple. The disposable communion cups provided potential messes, and the announcements needed to be excluded from the livestream. Those changes served their purposes, but the time has come to put things back the way they were. So beginning March 20, we will be changing our order of worship and putting everything back the way it was pre-COVID. Announcements will be at the start of worship and the Lord's Supper will be before the sermon. Nobody likes change, but this order seems better fitted to the needs of Shady Acres at this time. Thanks for your patience as we make this transition. (As part of this change, there will be means of disposing of the communion cups, and the announcements will still NOT be on the livestream, so you can anticipate a slight delay to the start of the livestream.)
