Time Marches On

Next Sunday, March 13, we will once again have the opportunity to do the metaphysically impossible. We're going to warp time. By the simple act of springing our clocks forward an hour, we will have made an hour disappear. Poof. Zip. Zing. No babies will be born between 2:00 and 3:00 am, no one will die in that time, and no one can make any middle-of-the-night impulse QVC purchases in that time. 2:00 am magically becomes 3:00 am, because we will have have done the impossible and warped time.

From the beginning in Genesis 1 (with the exception of Joshua 10), time has marched on undeterred. We know that with Daylight Savings Time that the hour doesn't really disappear; all we have done is reset our clocks. But the concept of time is one of those many things that the Spirit of God was working on in Genesis 1:2, and it certainly has stuck. Calendars have changed multiple times, but the clock has not. No one has come up with a better means of counting the days, so worldwide. throughout the history of time, everyone has always used a 24-hour clock. A few years ago there was an evolutionary push toward what is called the Day-Age Theory that stated that Genesis 1 was factually correct in its description of the Creation, but that the days of Genesis 1 weren't 24-hour days, but actually long eons of time. That theory turned out to have more holes than Swiss cheese and has now essentially been abandoned, but it left many wondering: how correct is Moses' account of Creation in Genesis 1? And the question ultimately becomes, can we trust our Bibles? One thing that feels unnatural to us when reading Genesis 1 is the statement that is repeated with each day's work, "and the evening and the morning were the day" (verses 5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31). I said "unnatural" because we will almost always describe a day beginning with, well, the beginning. Sunrise starts the day. We go through the morning first, then the midday, and finally the evening. But Genesis 1:1-5 describes for us the only day in history that did not have a sunrise. It began in the middle, so that the very first evening came before the very first sunrise.

Is the Bible correct in its description? Absolutely. And in an unnatural-feeling description of time, the evidence of Creation—and the inspiration of Scripture—becomes increasingly clear.
