Surprises In The Church

This month we have been taking a broad look at the book of Ephesians and appreciating the love that Paul displays for the church of our Lord and Savior. So far we have looked at "What Is the Church?", "What Is Jesus to the Church?", and "What Are the Elders to the Church?", with "What Am I to the Church?" coming up this Sunday. Needless to say, we're covering a lot in a short period of time. But there's something we're not likely to have time to dig into: What surprises do we find in the church? Paul reveals some things you might not expect.

First, read Ephesians 1:23. "Which is his body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all." The church is His fullness! Do we understand what that means? It means that the church takes up so much of Jesus that there is no room for anything else. But here's the interesting part: the church didn't consume Jesus; He bought it (Acts 20:28)! That means that this is the way the Father and Son wanted it to be.

Second, read Ephesians 3:10. "To the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places." If you have ever desired the wisdom of God, Paul tells us where to look: in the church. Many have looked to cards, to the stars, or to the collective wisdom of humanity. To think that all this time, the wisdom of God has been right under our noses.

Third, read Ephesians 3:21. "To Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen." Where is God to be glorified today? Nowhere but in the church. Who is this for? All generations. When is this valid for? Forever and ever, from now on. So be it (Amen)! If you want to glorify God today, the church is the only place to do it.

So there you have it. Three things in the church that you didn't see coming. Let us love and appreciate the church as much as Paul does because of the tremendous love of Christ.
