Nine Feet at a Time

I remember the first time I went to cut hay alone. The field was about ten acres, and I was on a John Deere tractor with a 9-foot haybine. It took about 25 minutes just to make the first pass around the field, and when dad came down to check on me about 3 hours later, I had only completed about a dozen passes. Nine times twelve is one hundred and eight. All that time and I was only 108 feet from the edge of the field, and more than a little discouraged. Dad said it looked like I was doing well. I replied that I didn't think so, and that I wasn't sure I would be able to finish cutting it all that day. Dad answered, "What do you mean? You're over halfway done." Sure enough, in about another three hours the entire field was cut.

It was difficult to believe that a hundred feet from the edge of the field was about half of its entire area. (I would assume we could do the math and figure it out exactly, but we were just using the clock.) But what amazed me the most, I suppose, was that nine feet at a time really made a difference. And isn't that so true of life? We can go round and round and feel like we're not really getting anywhere, and not seeing the difference that is being made.

It is so easy to get discouraged! We want to be positive, godly influences on those around us, but all too often we don't see the results we hope to see. We want to see lives and hearts changed. We want others to know the same love and hope that comes to us from being in Christ Jesus. And when that's not what we see, we can feel as though we are ineffective. When we forget the power that a little leaven has (see Matthew 13:33), we forget about God's power working in us (Ephesians 3:20) and through us. Paul wrote, "And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart" (Galatians 6:9). Likewise he said, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase" (1 Corinthians 3:6).

You are making a difference. God is making a difference. This tremendous influence is being felt in your homes, your families, your neighborhoods, your town, and your country. Much like with a 9-foot haybine, the progress may be seemingly imperceptible, but progress is there. Paul encourages with these words: "But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness" (1 Timothy 6:11). Keep making a difference!


