The story is told of a Christian high school senior who was honored as one of the best and brightest in his community because he provided a forceful demonstration of integrity.

When his school team was given the word "auditorium" in a regional spelling bee, he glanced down to ponder his response and noticed that the word was printed on the microphone stand.
