The ranch consists of 320 acres approximately 37 miles northeast of Pioche, Nevada. The land was given to the association by “Tex” and Beverly Fry for use as a campground, conference center, retreats etc.

The original house was built in 1860 and is one of the oldest building in Lincoln County. It houses our kitchen and multi-purpose meeting room. In addition to the house we have 4 12-person cabins, a bathhouse, and numerous out buildings. Additionally there is room for travel trailers and RV’s.

Wilson Creek runs through the property. Drinking water comes from a spring fed pipeline. The land is partially a meadow with a large area of various types of trees. Elevation of the property is 6,800 ft.

THE GOAL OF THIS FACILITY

Our goal is to see this facility being used year around for the edification in Christian fellowship, teaching and preaching of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ in a setting that enhances ones experience of the beautiful world our God has created.

WAYS TO BE INVOLVED:

It is located 220 miles north of Las Vegas and rests in the foothills of Mt. Wilson. It consists of 320 acres with minimal facilities.

UPCOMING PROJECTS:

- ◆ The clearing of the needed land for the purchase and building of a 50'x90' multipurpose building.
- ◆ The installation of sidewalks leading to the cabins and restrooms.
- ◆ The completion of the generator and water sheds.
- ◆ The repair of the backhoe.
- ◆ The completion of the removal of the remainder of unwanted wood and debris.
- ◆ The grading of the property around the cabins for new grass areas.

NEW BUILDING PROJECT:

At the 63rd Annual Meeting of the Southern Nevada Baptist Association, messengers from the churches approved the construction of a new building. The building is to be constructed in Spring, 2017. It will either be a 40x80, 50x90 or 60x100 depending on funds received.

The building will be built by gifts to the Association designated "Fry Ranch Construction." Currently, \$70,000 has been pledged. The Association messengers voted to guarantee at least \$30,000 additional funds to be available if sufficient funds are not raised.

The building will be used for recreation, dining and worship. The cost is \$20 per square foot for the foundation and structure.

Contributions are being accepted between now and March 31, 2017. Churches and individuals are welcome to participate.
