

STUDY QUESTIONS

REACH | MULTIPLICATION (PART 1)

Acts 13:1-3 | 14:24-28

Refresh your memory by reading: Matthew 28:18-20 | Acts 13:1-3 | 14:24-28

1. Why do you think multiplication (churches, leaders, disciples) is essential to fulfilling the mission Jesus gave in the Gospel of Matthew 28:19–20?
2. The sermon described Antioch as a “launching pad.” What made that church effective at sending?
3. When you hear “every man, woman, and child within our reach,” what emotions or thoughts come up for you?
4. Do you tend to view yourself more as a **sender, goer**, or **spectator** right now? Why?
5. The sermon said, “Wherever your feet are, that’s your mission field.” Where has God placed you right now (work, neighborhood, relationships), and how can you be more intentional there?
6. What would it look like for you to “get off the sidelines” and engage more fully in the mission of the church? Is there a step you can take toward leadership (serving, leading a group, mentoring someone)? What’s holding you back?
7. Why do you think new churches often reach people more effectively than established ones?
8. How would adopting a “sending mentality” change the way you view people leaving your church to plant or serve elsewhere?
9. What would it look like for our group to contribute to multiplication (disciples, leaders, or churches)?
10. How does understanding that God owns everything (1 Chronicles 29:11–14) change the way you think about money?
11. The sermon said every spending decision is a spiritual decision—do you agree? Why or why not?

12. What is one practical step you can take to grow in generosity right now?
13. What is **one clear next step** God may be calling you to take after this message? How can this group support you in taking that step?

Prayer prompts:

Ask God to give your group a heart for multiplication

Pray for boldness to share the gospel

Pray for clarity on personal next steps (go, send, lead, give)
