This guide is designed to help you reflect on and apply what you learned from the sermon this weekend. Use this guide as a quiet time this week. Write your answers in a journal, with the date and main passage noted at the top of the page.

- What main point from the sermon stood out to you? What did the Holy Spirit convict you of or encourage you with?
- What do you (or did you) do for work? What eternal significance – if any – can you see in your work?
- **Read Colossians 3:22-25.** What timeless principle in verse 22 relates to being an employee in the workplace?
- How would you contrast “external service” and work that is done in “sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord”?
- According to verse 22, why work hard if you can get by with minimum effort?
- What motivates you to do excellent work? What motivation does Paul mention in verse 23 and 25?
- How should Christians respond to unfair treatment by their supervisors?
- **Read Ephesians 6:5-9.** Why do you think Paul emphasizes the importance of an employee’s attitude so much here? What makes it especially challenging to practice submission in the workplace?
- What instructions does Paul give to employers? How would that play out today?
- **Read John 13:12-17.** What do we learn about submission in the workplace by Jesus’ example?
- How might our community be different if people willingly submitted to their bosses and coworkers?
- Based on our passages, what should employers expect from employees? What should employees expect from employers?
- What step might you take this week to approach work with an eternal perspective? How might you point people to Christ in the way you work?
- Based on this passage or the sermon, what is one step of obedience the Holy Spirit is leading you towards this week?
