

PERSONAL REFLECTION GUIDE

At Southland Church, we are committed to help you KNOW Christ, LIVE like Him, and make Him KNOWN. This guide is designed to help you reflect on and apply what you learned from the sermon this weekend. Use this guide as a quiet time this week. Write your answers in a journal, with the date and main passage noted at the top of the page.

- What main point from the sermon stood out to you? What did the Holy Spirit convict you of or encourage you with?
- When is a time that your boss or superior asked you to do something intimidating? What was it, and how did you respond?
- **Read Exodus 3:1-10.** This is a passage that emphasizes the holiness of God. What experiences have led you to sense the magnitude of God's holiness? How did you respond in those moments?
- What do you learn about God's heart for His people in verses 7-10?
- What are some common reasons people resist doing challenging things?
- **Read Exodus 3:11-15.** When was the last time your past caused you to hesitate saying "yes" to an opportunity God placed before you?
- How important is the strength of your relationship with God when you attempt intimidating tasks? Why do you think so?
- **Read Exodus 3:16-22.** Recall a time when you had to trust God in a critical situation. Did you know how everything would work out?
- God warned Moses that Pharaoh would refuse his request. Why is it important to understand that obeying God doesn't always lead to easy circumstances?
- When you think of God calling you to serve Him, how do you respond? Do you feel like He couldn't use you because of your past? Do you focus on your ability?
- How does it impact your willingness to say "yes" to serving God when you understand that God will be with you, and that His power is ultimately responsible for accomplishing the task?
- God's will is for every Christian to be involved in His redemptive work. What is your involvement in the church right now? How might you serve its mission?
- Based on this passage or the sermon, what is one step of obedience the Holy Spirit is leading you towards this week?
