At Southland Church, we are committed to help you KNOW Christ, LIVE like Him, and make Him KNOWN. This guide is designed to help you reflect on and apply what you learned from the sermon this weekend. Use this guide as a quiet time this week. Write your answers in a journal, with the date and main passage noted at the top of the page.

- What main point from the sermon stood out to you? What did the Holy Spirit convict you of or encourage you with?
- What do you consider to be the biggest challenge you have faced? Looking back, what would you do differently about how you faced it?
- **Read Daniel 6:1-10.** How did Daniel's relationship with God open him up to attacks from his enemies?
- How were faith and culture in conflict in this passage?
- How did Daniel react to the news of the king's new law? What implications does Daniel's public display of faith have for our prayer lives?
- What is one way your own faith in God is challenged by our culture?
- **Read Daniel 6:11-18.** What do you learn about God from the contrast between the king and Daniel in these verses?
- **Read Daniel 6:19-24.** What does God's deliverance of Daniel teach us about God?
- We know from life that God does not always rescue the faithful from harm. If God does not respond in a miraculous way, how should His followers respond?
- What effect did God's deliverance of Daniel have on Darius?
- Daniel's faith was validated by the intervention of God. How has God proven Himself faithful in your life recently?
- What aspects of our culture today hinder the discipline of prayer? How do you face those challenges in your own prayer life?
- Daniel's purpose in life was to glorify God. How is that purpose different from the purpose of your life today? What is one immediate difference you would see if glorifying God became the sole focus of your life?
- Based on this passage or the sermon, what is one step of obedience the Holy Spirit is leading you towards this week?
