

PERSONAL REFLECTION GUIDE

At Southland Church, we are committed to help you KNOW Christ, LIVE like Him, and make Him KNOWN. This guide is designed to help you reflect on and apply what you learned from the sermon this weekend. Use this guide as a quiet time this week. Write your answers in a journal, with the date and main passage noted at the top of the page.

- What main point from the sermon stood out to you? What did the Holy Spirit convict you of or encourage you with?
- How do you personally define faithfulness?
- Why is it tempting to base our faith on visible results? What is the danger of doing so?
- **Read Exodus 5:19-23.** Name at least 3 accusations Moses had of God. Which accusation do you personally find most tempting when life gets difficult?
- Write/Tell of a time when you were "shaking your fist at God" because He didn't follow your timeline or method.
- **Read Exodus 6:1-9.** Rather than a stern rebuke, God responds with a gracious reminder. What does this tell you about God's character, and how He responds to honest doubt?
- God says He is about to reveal His name in a new way. What is the difference between knowing His name as a word versus knowing by experience?
- Review the "I will" promises in verses 6-8. What does God promise, and why is His declaration of "I am the Lord" their only necessary validation?
- In verse 9, Israel didn't listen because of their impatience of spirit and harsh slavery. How does our impatience make circumstances feel more real than God's Word?
- What is one situation in your life right now that is speaking louder than God?
- Why is it arrogant to think we will eventually not need to be reminded of the Gospel? How can you make being reminded a priority in your schedule?
- Who in your life is experiencing a period of darkness? How can you specifically remind them this week that God hears them and keeps His promises?
- Based on this passage or the sermon, what is one step of obedience the Holy Spirit is leading you towards this week?
