This is the opening to Packer's book, *18 Words: The Most Important Words You Will Ever Know*. Our purpose in this study is laid out by the author with this statement, "My selection of themes reflects a purpose of spelling out the gospel, which is the Bible's central message." If the gospel is the central message of the Bible, it is to be central in the life of the church and in the life of each believer. The gospel that saves us is the same gospel that keeps us saved. Our hope is that, through our study together, we will all have a better understanding of these "18 words," moving us to prize and cherish the gospel in much greater ways.
