ABOUT THE SACRAMENT OF COMMUNION

We welcome to the Lord's Table all who have been baptized, belong to a church which embraces the Gospel, and who look in faith to the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior. Since Communion is a sacrament of sustaining grace, we request that children not participate until they have professed their faith to the elders of this church or their church of regular worship.

As the communion servers pass in front of you, please remember to take **both** of the stacked cups from the tray. Note that the bread is in the bottom cup and is gluten-free. Grape juice is in the colored cups in the outer ring, wine is in the clear cups in the inner rings.

The Lord Jesus, on the night of his arrest, took bread, and after giving thanks to God, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

RYAN AND KATIE PEKAREK CLAIRE AND SARAH Mission to the World, Central Asia

Ryan and Katie are vocational workers supporting local churches in a major city in Central Asia. They serve in a Muslim majority country where religious work is illegal. As such, their professions serve as platforms for being in the country, as well as a means to be involved in the community. Ryan is a project manager and co-director of a small business that sources local handicrafts and provides a fair marketplace for rural and local artisans. Katie is a physician and works at a private clinic, with the hope of being able to expand access to care to the poor rural regions outside the city as well as increase medical education access.

Together, Ryan and Katie work with a small local church. Their primary focus revolves around helping their team organize local and regional theological education to identify and train new church leaders. They minister alongside a small local reformed Presbyterian church that is pastored by national partners. The church is small but growing steadily and hopefully will be ready soon to consider planting another church in the city. While training up new local leaders, they are assisting the existing local church to develop the resources and passion for planting more reformed Presbyterian churches throughout the region. They have two children, Claire and Sarah.
