Toddlers in our Nursery Ministry hear Bible stories and participate in activities from the *Show Me Jesus* curriculum as they build a sure foundation.

Our Elementary Students will all be using curriculum by Great Commission Publications. This quarter our **Pre-K** and **Kindergarten students** will learn about Jesus' great love for his people, his death, resurrection, his ascension, the promised Holy Spirit, and the Lord's return one day. The **Lower Elementary Sunday school class (grades 1-2)** will be focusing on what it means to become devoted to God's Word using stories and passages from both the Old and New Testaments. **Upper Elementary Sunday School (grades 3-5)** will continue working through a two-year Bible survey course helping students desire God's word and grow closer in relationship with Christ. Students will discover the joy of being called to be a part of this grand narrative of redemption as they study the scriptures together!

Built for a Purpose is a week-long skills camp for boys entering 4th-9th grade. The purpose of the camp is to teach the boys that they were created in the image of God, by God, and for God. Men from the church will encourage, teach, and mentor the boys through building projects, archery, gun safety/BB guns, games, and activities, all culminating in worship and small group time each night. Our goal is for the boys to recognize that they are sinners in need of a Savior, and that Jesus Christ is the only savior of man. The projects, activities, and devotionals are all designed to point the participants to Christ.
