MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK August 16, 2020

PAUL & LAURA MILLER & JACK Texas Regional Director Metanoia Prison Ministry PCA Mission to North America



After Paul graduated from Westminster Theological Seminary, he and Laura launched RUF at Texas A&M Corpus Christi (TAMUCC) in 2008. Paul served seven years as campus minister at TAMUCC. He has served as an assistant and associate pastor in the PCA, as a hospital chaplain at Methodist Hospital in Dallas, and now serves as the Texas Regional Director of Metanoia Prison Ministries, the official prison ministry of the PCA.

Metanoia (meh-tuh-noy-uh) chose its name because it is the Greek word for repentance, signifying turning from a life of sin to a life that is lived for the glory of God. They partner with churches by providing discipleship and outreach to prisoners in the churches' communities.

Pray

- That the LORD will keep inmates and prison officials safe from COVID-19.
- That the LORD will make a way for us to go back into prisons in person, according to His timing.
- That Metanoia will continue to reach inmates with the gospel and continue to disciple them in the faith through our correspondence program.
- That the LORD will continue to raise up champion churches* here in Texas to serve the prison population.

*A *champion church* is a church that is connected to Metanoia through at least two of these ministry avenues, (a) making financial contributions to Metanoia, (b) participating in our correspondence ministry, (c) willing to train mentors, or willing to be a church that helps with reintegration of exoffenders.

August 2 - Julian Zugg, International English Director, MINTS

Julian Zugg was born in England and raised in South Africa. In 1986, he moved back to England, where he read Law, qualified as a Barrister (US trial lawyer), and taught Law at Buckingham University for eight years. In 2001, he graduated from Reformed Theological Seminary (MDiv. Jackson) and worked as an assistant/associate minster involved in all areas of pastoral ministry in the PCA from 2002-2008. In 2008, he was called as the Director of Theology at Belize Presbyterian Theological Seminary, Belize. He is currently the Provost and International English Director for MINTS (Miami International Seminary), where his

duties include teaching, writing, developing, and supporting MINTS centers in eleven countries.



August 9 - Brooks Harwood, RUF Campus Minister, University of Houston, Texas Brooks was born in Texas and grew up in Nashville, TN. He attended the University of Tennessee in Knoxville and later got a pastoral degree from Covenant Theological Seminary (CTS) in St. Louis, MO. He and his wife Meredith met at RUF at the University of Tennessee and after graduation were married and moved to Nashville where Meredith served as an RUF intern at Vanderbilt University. After completing his degree at CTS, Brooks became the RUF Campus Minister at the University of Houston (UH). UH is the sixth most ethnically diverse university in the nation with

students from many nationalities and religious traditions
